Special Note: This 13th meeting marks a successful point in our water supply reliability history. We now have selected a regional water supply strategy that includes conservation, stormwater reuse, 100% water recycling, and some desalination possibly from brackish groundwater treatment. We propose to contribute to the further remediation of the Salinas groundwater basin salinity problem, possibly replace all the water from the Carmel River, and power it all with local electricity produced from methane at the Monterey Peninsula Landfill, and Landfill Gas Renewable Energy facility adjacent to the Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant.
